Permit Classes will be made available if exhibitors request. All "Good as Gold" permit program horses must verify a Palomino parent, and own/exhibitor MUST possess or purchase a permit program card. See official handbook for rules.

Performance classes - Exhibitors must provide a ROM Certificate or Proof of Certificate from PHBA. See official handbook for rules.

**PHBA Entry Fee:** All entry fees are per horse, per judge, each day or \$40.00 maximum per horse, per judge, each day – no matter how many divisions you show in or how many exhibitors show the horse. (\$120.00 per day max-out per horse). Special incentive for horses age 2 and under: All class fees for horses age 2 and under will be \$5.00 per class per judge.

**PHBA Permit Fees:** Must have a permit issued by PHBA prior to the show. All entry fees are per horse, one judge each day. \$15.00 per class with 80% jackpot paid back plus office fee. For more details on the permit program visit [www.palominohba.com](http://www.palominohba.com).

**PHBA Additional Fees:** Computer administration fee and office charges: \$6.00 per horse, per judge, per day. (\$18.00 per day per horse).  
**Camping Fees:** \$15.00 per day (NOTE: this is charged whether you use electric or not)

**Stalls:** \$52.00 for the weekend. Day stalls are \$22.00 each day (this replaces the jump out fee). An additional \$10.00 will be charged for stalls occupied before 7:00 P.M. on Thursday. NO EXCEPTIONS. Shavings are available for \$7.00 per bag. Note: Stalls are cement.

**OPEN Class Entry Fees:** \$5.00 per class. Open class office fee: \$6.00 per horse. No jump out fee. Any horse which was maxed out in PHBA classes will have a \$20.00 max out fee in open.

**OPEN Show** high-point awards will be combined points for Saturday and Sunday shows for three divisions: Tiny Tot Exhibitor-age 10 and under (cross over allowed). JR Exhibitor, age 18 and under (cross over allowed) and Open Exhibitor, any age.

**Hi-Point Circuit Awards for PHBA classes; to be eligible you must show all 3 days; awarded on PHBA points.**

**ALL PHBA class entrants must provide a COPY of their PHBA card and a COPY of their horse's papers to the show secretary. If you forget your card or do not have one you will be required to purchase a non-refundable temporary membership. Temporary membership must be purchased with a separate check made payable to PHBA.**

All horses must have an original and one copy of a current negative coggins test paper (drawn in 2010). Copy is to be left on file in the office. All out of state horses must have current interstate health papers.

#### **Wisconsin Members:**

Year-end awards. To be eligible for year-end awards, you must show the same horse at least two of the three days, at both the June and the August shows in each category and be present at our annual meeting for each division in which you qualify. Plus you or a member of your immediate family must sell one ad for our annual promotional booklet. The booklet is printed in the spring, and the ads must be submitted by March 15<sup>th</sup> for publication in the current year's booklet. All ads must be submitted and paid in full prior to the start of the August Show to qualify for that year hi-point awards. Ads submitted after March 15<sup>th</sup> will be published in the following year's booklet. Check with the show secretary for more information.

All PHBA class entrants must provide a COPY of their PHBA card and a COPY of their horses' papers to the show secretary, if you forget your card or do not have one you will be required to purchase a non-refundable temporary membership, purchased with a separate check made payable to PHBA.

**All horses** must have an original and one copy of a current negative coggins test paper (drawn in 2010). Copy to be left on file in the office. All out of state horses must have current interstate health papers.

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

**From the north:** Take I-90 until you get to Madison, then take I-94 towards Milwaukee. Take I-94 to the Johnson Creek exits, Hwy 26. Take Hwy 26 south towards Jefferson. In Jefferson continue to Hwy N, turn right and continue over a bridge and for another couple of blocks to the stop sign. Fairgrounds will be straight ahead, entrance is 1 block to your right.

**From the south:** Take I-90 towards Janesville. At Janesville take Hwy 26 north towards Fort Atkinson and Jefferson area. Go past Fort Atkinson on the bypass (stay on 26) to Jefferson. In Jefferson, when you get to the stop lights turn left onto Hwy 18 W. Continue on Hwy 18 over a bridge and an additional 4 blocks, turn right onto Jackson Street. Go a couple blocks and the fairgrounds will be on your left.

**From Highways 151, 18 14 and 12(west & south beltline) in Madison:** Stay on Hwy 12/18 South through Madison and continue towards Cambridge and Jefferson area. Follow Hwy 18 when it turns off to the left, (stay on 18). As you come into Jefferson, turn left onto Jackson St. Go a couple of blocks and the fairgrounds will be on your left.
